- 2018 was a challenging year for the CCMTB Club Committee. Many roles were filled by people stepping into vacant roles. Paul Cook stepped into the vacancy of Club President in July. Despite the changes, our Committee have pushed forward focusing on success, and more importantly – outcomes.
